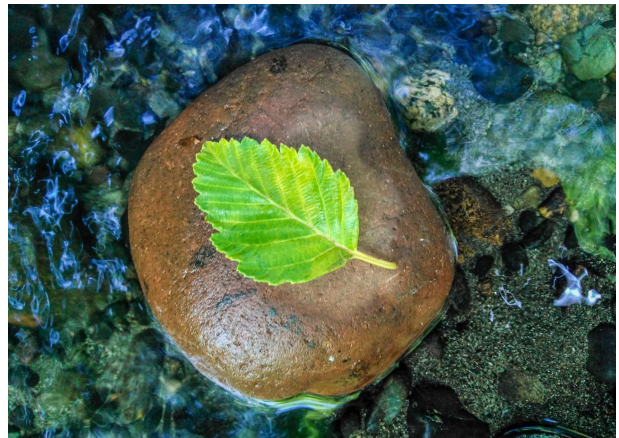

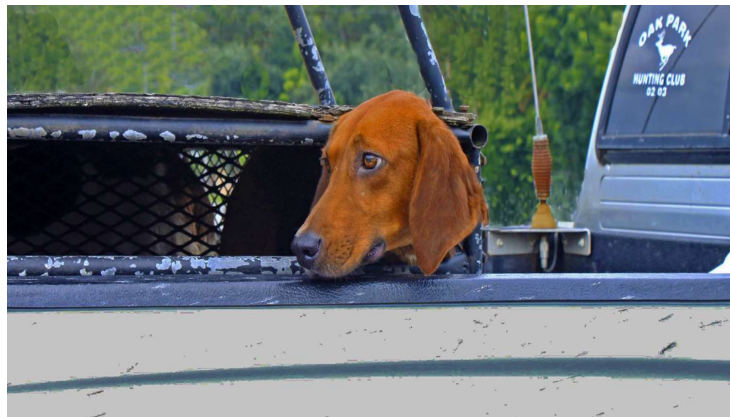
Adelet Kegley, Gloria Lotzer, Kathleen Pruett and Linda and Paul Johnson joined us after the photo was taken.
